TOWN OF SIOUX CREEK DOG LICENSE APPLICATION

If you own a dog, please complete the bottom portion and return it to the Town of Sioux Creek along with the proper fees.

Wisconsin statutes require dogs 5 months of age or older to be licensed and vaccinated by a veterinarian for rabies.

• LICENSE FEE: \$5 NEUTERED OR SPAYED \$10 UN-NEUTERED OR UN-SPAYED

Pay your dog fees with cash or a **separate check from your taxes.** Please include a **CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE** if one is not already on file at the Town. This is not a receipt from your vet clinic but the actual **vaccination certificate**. If you do not have one, you can obtain another copy from your vet clinic. It should include the rabies tag number, date of vaccination and expiration date, vet/clinic name, name of the dog, male or female and if they are spayed or neutered. The certificate will be returned with your tags and receipt.

Notify the Treasurer if your dog has passed or if you no longer own your dog.

- LATE FEES:
 - After **March 31st** a **\$5.00** late fee will be charged for **EACH** dog, and if not paid within the 10-day grace period the matter will be referred to the Barron County Sheriff's Department. Persons with unlicensed dogs are subject to a minimum fine of **\$169**.
- To report **animal issues** such as a lost dog, stray dogs, or animal abuse call the Barron County Animal Enforcement Officer at **715-537-3106**.
- LANDLORDS---Please notify your tenants of the dog license requirements.
- Multiple Dog Licenses are available for \$35.00 for up to 12 dogs, additional at \$5.00 each
