
WHEREAS, Wis. Stat. § 349.16 authorizes a town board to place seasonal weight limits on its highways; and


WHEREAS, such weight limitations are effective when signs are erected consistent with Wis. Stat. § 349.16(2).


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Sioux Creek (the “Town Board”), Barron County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:


1. ADOPTION: All town highways in the Town of Sioux Creek are subject to the following seasonal weight restrictions when posted:
  - a. 15 tons.
2. EFFECTIVE: Seasonal weight restrictions are effective twenty-four (24) hours after the erection of signs by the Road Superintendent, or his/her designee, and expire upon removal of the signs by the Road Superintendent, or his/her designee.
3. AUTHORITY: The Road Superintendent, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized to determine when seasonal weight restriction signs should be erected and removed from town roads.
4. MODIFICATION: This Continuing Resolution may be modified or revoked by subsequent action of the Town Board.
5. VIOLATION: No person shall operate any vehicles on town roads in violation of the weight restrictions imposed in Section 1 of this resolution without first obtaining a written permit from the Town Board. Any violation of this resolution shall be subject to penalties described in Wis. Stat. § 348.21, as amended.
